



## WHAT IS COVERED

The Dealership will pay for 100% of the total cost of the parts and labor necessary to repair or replace the Covered Items listed below, less a deductible of \$200.00, which you are required to pay, if the defect or malfunction in the Covered Part is caused by a mechanical breakdown or failure under normal service (the inability of any covered part to perform its designed function):

**Engine:** Cylinder Block and all Internal Parts; Cylinder Head Assemblies, Head Gaskets, Timing Case, Chain, Gears, Belt and Sprockets; Harmonic Balancer; Oil Pump; Water Pump; Turbocharger Housing and all Internal Parts; Turbocharger Wastegate Actuator, Serpentine Belt Tensioner. Burnt valves and worn piston rings are not covered.

**Transmission:** Transmission Case and all Internal Parts; Torque Converter; Drive Plate; Flex Plate; Fly Wheel; Bell Housing. Manual Transmission Clutch Parts are not covered at any time.

**Front-Wheel-Drive:** Transaxle Case and all Internal Parts;

Drive Shaft and Axle Shaft Assemblies and their Housings; Constant Velocity Joints and Boots.

**Rear-Wheel-Drive:** Rear Axle Housing and all Internal Parts; Axle Shafts; Axle Shaft Bearings; Drive Shaft Assemblies; Drive Shaft Center Bearings; Universal Joints and Yokes.

**Four-Wheel-Drive (4 X 4)/All Wheel Drive (AWD):** Transfer Case/Power Transfer Unit and all Internal Parts; Front and Rear Axle Assemblies; Axle Shafts; Axle Shaft Bearings; Drive Shaft Assemblies; Universal Joints and Yokes; Viscous Coupler Assembly.

## WHAT IS NOT COVERED

Any part of the vehicle not listed under "WHAT IS COVERED" is excluded from coverage under this Limited Warranty. In addition, the Dealership shall not be obligated to repair or replace parts under this Limited Warranty if:

- Maintenance on the vehicle is not performed in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations (We may require you, upon request, to provide copies of maintenance records and receipts indicating dates, mileage and services performed).
- The repair or replacement is due to the lack of maintaining appropriate fluid levels (e.g. oil, water, transmission fluid).
- The vehicle is operated continuously after the occurrence of a mechanical breakdown or warning light notice.
- The repair or replacement is required as a result of the failure of a non-covered part.
- The vehicle has been modified from or operated in a manner that is not in conformance with the manufacturer's specifications or intended use.
- The repair or replacement is required as a result of other than a manufacturing defect (such as a design defect or normal wear).

- The repair or replacement is due to an accident or collision; improper or contaminated fuel or other fluids; misuse, abuse, tampering, negligence, theft, vandalism, acts of nature or God; use of the vehicle for competitive speed events such as races or acceleration trials; pulling a trailer that exceeds the rated capacity of the vehicle or failure to adhere to the requirements for vehicles used to pull a trailer as outlined in the owner literature provided by the manufacturer.
- The repair or replacement is of any component covered by a manufacturer's warranty, any recall campaign or any repair covered by an adjustment program that applies after the new vehicle warranty expires;
- The odometer reading (mileage) has been stopped or altered (unless mileage is shown by a doorpost sticker that complies with Federal Law) or the vehicle's actual mileage cannot be readily determined.

## THE DEALERSHIP'S RESPONSIBILITIES

During the Term of this Limited Warranty, as defined on the front side of this document, the Dealership will repair any covered Item(s) upon your written authorization and subject to the provisions of this Limited Warranty. The Dealership may, at its sole discretion, use used or remanufactured parts. The timeliness of the service or repair may be affected by the availability of replacement parts. Upon re-delivery of the vehicle to you, you must pay for any expenses, plus applicable taxes, that the Dealership is not obligated to provide or pay for under this Limited Warranty and all expenses incurred to remedy defects to or malfunctions of part(s) other than those covered by this Limited Warranty shall be your responsibility. **Important:** The maximum reimbursable amount if a Covered Part fails will be THE TOTAL COST OF THE REPAIRS, PER VISIT, OR THE CASH VALUE OF THE VEHICLE, WHICHEVER IS LESS. The cash value of the vehicle will be determined by the average retail value as listed in the current NADA Used Car Pricing Guide.

## YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES AND WHAT TO DO IF REPAIRS ARE NEEDED

You are responsible under the terms of this Limited Warranty for properly operating, caring for and maintaining the vehicle as prescribed by the manufacturer. **You should retain all maintenance receipts to avoid any misunderstandings as to whether or not maintenance services were performed as required.** To obtain coverage under this Limited Warranty, you must notify the Administrator of any failure, malfunction or defect of any Covered Part(s) and deliver the Vehicle to the Selling Dealership at its place of business within 5 days of providing such notice for any warranty work to be performed, unless we agree otherwise. You must authorize in writing all repair work to be performed under this Limited Warranty. We reserve the right to inspect the vehicle both prior to and after a service/repair is performed. We may refuse to reimburse you for the cost of any services or repairs to Covered Parts if you do not obtain advance written authorization from us to have them performed, if you fail to make the vehicle available for inspection and/or if you are not able to provide us with written receipts. Upon re-delivery of the repaired vehicle to you, you must pay the deductible amount and for any expenses (including applicable sales taxes) that are not covered pursuant to the terms of this Limited Warranty.
